


130a. 2240 a: shaft from its top, showing construction and top of entrance to burial chamber (rg 9-19, 1989)









130b. Part of head, from debris on top of 2230, but possibly originally from 2240 serdab. 39-2-7 (b 9058)





130d. Displaced fragments of relief (some probably of the Fourth Dynasty) from the top of 2230+2231 (c 14270)



131. Plan of the Western Cemetery at Giza showing the cluster of tombs of palace attendants









133. The 1990 revised plan of the cluster, western end




134. The 1990 revised plan of the cluster, center part




135. The 1990 revised plan of the cluster, eastern end






137. North-south section of the cluster, with elevations of the remains of 2092a. (See pp. 8-9)











143. 2086: North wall of chapel. (See pl. 18b)




144. 2086: North pilaster at entrance to chapel. (See pl. 19a)




145a, b. 2087: West (right) and east door jambs at southern entrance. (See pl. 23)










149. 2088: Lintel fragment from portico. (See pl. 30a)













152c. 2088: Loose block from the top of shaft z


152b. 2088: Secondary false door set in embrasure north of chapel entrance. (See pl. 31c)











155. 2091: West wall of corridor, south end






156. 2091: West wall of corridor, north end










158. 2091: East wall of corridor, north end. (See pl. 42a)






159. 2091: East wall of corridor, south end





160a. 2091: Unplaced decoration from corridor




165. 2091: Lintel over false doors on west wall of chapel. (See pl. 55)








166. 2091: Decoration on both ends of west wall above lintel. (See pls. 55a, 55c)






167. 2091: North wall of chapel. (See pls. 56, 57, 58)











172a. 2092+2093: Unfinished inscription on entrance drum lintel. (See pl. 67)






172b. 2092+2093: North end of west wall of corridor into chapel. (See pl. 68a)






172c. 2092+2093: Loose block. (See pl. 68b)








173b, c. 2092+2093: Loose blocks. All blocks seem to belong to the same scene. (See pl. 68d)


177. 2092+2093: Architrave fragment from path south of mastaba. (See pl. 70a)















185. 2097: North wall of chapel. (See pls. 87, 88b, 89)




186. 2097: Intrusive inscription on palace facade door, west wall of chapel. (See pls. 90, 91)







193. 2098: West wall of chapel, decoration between false doors. (See pls. 105b, 106, 107a)




197. 2098: One of three decorated faces of pillar. (See pl. 109)







199. 2230+2231: Southern facade of mastaba 2231, showing inscription (probably intrusive). (See pl. 118c)






201a, b. 2240: Architrave from portico. (See pl. 122)




204. 2240: North wall of chapel. (See pl. 124a)





